Farm Visit

Dear parents/carers,

Over the next 3 weeks children will be learning about solids, liquids and gases through a creative topic 'Shake it!' where they will be making butter, cheese and milkshakes.

As part of the children's learning, we will be taking them to visit Norton Farm on Thursday 6th February. This will be a great opportunity for them to see where milk comes from, the processes involved in producing milk including how butter, cheese, barley and wheat are made/grown.

Children will need to bring wellington boots, a spare pair of shoes, a coat, hat, gloves and a scarf, normal school uniform (ensure trousers/thick tights).

Children will leave school at 9am and will return by the end of the school day. They will need a drink, a packed lunch or will need to order a school packed lunch, which will be eaten at the local Village Hall.
